<p>Student(s) are self-isolating</p>	<p>Curriculum arrangements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A-Level Further maths, Core maths and AS maths lessons have been streamed live since September and recorded for students to either join in or watch at a later date. Student work requirements are provided on the Teams platform with assignments set and resources in the files section. • For GCSE resit maths and Functional skills, students are being contacted via email or Teams and sent the required resources. <p>IT platform</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We are currently using MS Teams for live streaming and recording.
<p>The teacher is self-isolating</p>	<p>Curriculum arrangements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the teacher is isolating and well enough to work they will conduct the lesson via MS Teams and record it. Students are expected to join the live lesson at the normal lesson time. All Maths teachers have the ability to use their iPads to demonstrate examples and conduct a lesson in a similar way to being face-to-face in the classroom. • If the Teacher is not well enough to conduct the lesson online, work and other resources will be provided for the students on MS Teams, SharePoint or email by the line manager. <p>IT platform</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Either the online lesson will be conducted on Teams or a notice will be placed in the Class Teams Post with links to resources on SharePoint Maths@ONE and directions on what is to be done. An email to the whole class may also be utilised.
