| 31/08/20 | Year 13 students only onsite | Between 25% > 100% onsite, with the addition of online lessons “in real time” and for the full duration of the planned timetable. Subjects have slightly different patterns of attendance dependent on their precise nature. |
| 07/09/20 | Blended learning (between 25%-100%) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proportion of time onsite relates to subject type and the capacity of accommodation • Evolve/Progression tutorials are online • All offsite delivery is accounted for by “live” online delivery using MS Teams or Skype. • The balance of offsite delivery is monitored remotely via SharePoint, Google Classroom or Moodle. | <p>Induction To allow familiarisation with systems and allow adequate social distancing in communal spaces in the college.</p> <p>Embedding blended learning We wish to ensure that new students are fully familiarised with online platforms, in the event of further local or regional restrictions.</p> <p>Our chief priority as we reopen the building for learning is the real time safety of staff and students; OSFC is a unique site so we must ensure our whole community are fully trained and compliant with all control measures. Over half of the college are new members of the community. Therefore we allow time for this group to come onsite in a managed way.</p> |
| 14/09/20 | Blended learning (between 50%-100%) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Many academic/vocational subjects will shift to 50% onsite delivery • Wherever practicable, subjects to will be delivered 100% onsite | We will continue to build up attendance onsite - once confidence is assured and the implementation of any new requirements/ alterations are put in place. A number of students travel to learn for some considerable distance so we will make allowances for alterations to journeys. |
| 21/09/20 | All subjects to shift to onsite delivery | Allow time to implement measures to counteract increasing student numbers, to include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Non- student facing staff work from home - Adapt Risk Assessments - Create larger break out spaces - Review one ways to increase capacity where possible - Face coverings mandatory in communal and 1m+ spaces |
