Student(s) are self-isolating	<p>Curriculum arrangements</p> <p>Student(s) join the live lesson on Teams and access it in one or more of the following way(s)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teachers will either deliver their lessons live online or will email self-isolating students directly ahead of the lesson Teacher will deliver their lesson live online
	<p>IT platform</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lessons accessed via Microsoft Teams.
The teacher is self-isolating	<p>Curriculum arrangements</p> <p>Staff will teach within the designated timetabled period(s) and will be available at this time. Students 'attend' the lesson online, either onsite or offsite.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lessons will be delivered live online by teachers from home. Students can access lessons off site or if more convenient in their designated classroom if they liaise directly with their class teacher or with Head of Curriculum, Anthony Dee
