

Sporting Participation Interview for Sport Courses

To be a successful sport student you need to have a keen interest and active involvement in sport. Studying on any Sport course requires full commitment and a genuine interest and passion for the subject.

Will I need an interview?

- Evidence of your involvement in and commitment to sport is required for **all** students applying for:
 - BTEC Extended Diploma in Sport
 - BTEC Extended Certificate in Sport and Exercise Science
 - BTEC First Certificate in Sport/Fitness
 - Your interview at Suffolk One with one of our sport teachers will help us to ascertain whether you have the potential to achieve well on the sport courses we offer.

What do I need to bring?

- To demonstrate your involvement in and commitment to sport you will need to bring in evidence of your active involvement within sport. This could include the following:
 - A letter of recommendation from your coach or mentor.
 - Newspaper cuttings and scrap books of your achievements
 - Trophies, medals and certificates
 - Photographs and videos of your performances
 - Fixtures lists

How should I prepare?

Please be prepared to talk about your achievements within sport. Consider what skills you have demonstrated, what has inspired you, how often do you train and compete? What are your goals or aspirations within sport?
