AS PHOTOGRAPHY ASSIGNMENT

If you want to be considered for a place on AS Photography at Suffolk One then a photo assignment must be completed. The intention being that you demonstrate your level of interest and commitment to this very popular course.

Three Choices of Assignment

1. Produce a sequence of 10-12 photographs based upon the theme: A Familiar Journey Photographed in an Unfamiliar Way.
2. Produce a sequence of 10-12 photographs based upon the theme: Home.
3. Produce 10-12 photographs based upon the theme: My Suffolk.

How Will Your Work be Considered?

Your response to the assignment is an opportunity for you to look at your environment imaginatively and to use your camera creatively. Therefore, you may wish to consider camera-angle, point-of-view, contrast, framing, camera technique, composition etc...

Camera Specification

In order to exercise control of the photographic image, students enrolling on the AS Photography course are strongly recommended to purchase their own digital camera with full manual control. Information concerning camera requirements is available from Suffolk One.

When you are called for interview – please bring hard copies of your photographs and be prepared to discuss how you have interpreted your chosen assignment with your interviewer.
